This term we look forward to celebrating Book Week, meeting a real-life author and participating in a Silly Scientist Incursion.

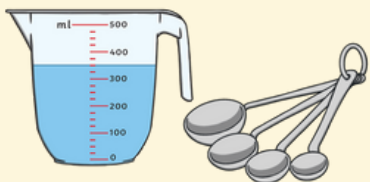
